

The Academy of Veterinary Clinical Pathology Technicians

Instructions for Confidential Letters of Recommendation

- 1) Submit two letters of recommendation. Each letter must come from two different categories listed below:
 - An AVCPT member
 - A supporting veterinarian
 - A supporting credentialed veterinary technician
 - A member of the American Society of Veterinary Clinical Pathology (ASVCP)
 - A veterinary technology specialist (VTS) in any of the NAVTA approved specialties

For example, you may request a recommendation letter from the veterinarian with whom you are employed and a one from a credentialed veterinary technician with whom you work.

- 2) Fill out the candidate information section of the Confidential Letter of Recommendation Form.
- 3) Print **two** copies of the form.
- 4) Give one form to each of the qualified people, as indicated by the categories listed above, from whom you are requesting a recommendation.
- 5) Remind your references that recommendation letters **must** be submitted directly to AVCPT by the letter writer. The letter writer may submit their letter of recommendation directly to AVCPT by scanning the word processed document and emailing it to avcpt.vts@gmail.com or the original letter can be mailed to the following address:

- 6) Remind your references that their letter of recommendation is due by the application deadline.
- 7) You will receive notice of when a letter of recommendation is received from the AVCPT credentialing committee.
- 8) Letters of recommendation that are not signed by the letter writer and received directly from those making the recommendation or two letters from the same category will be rejected.
